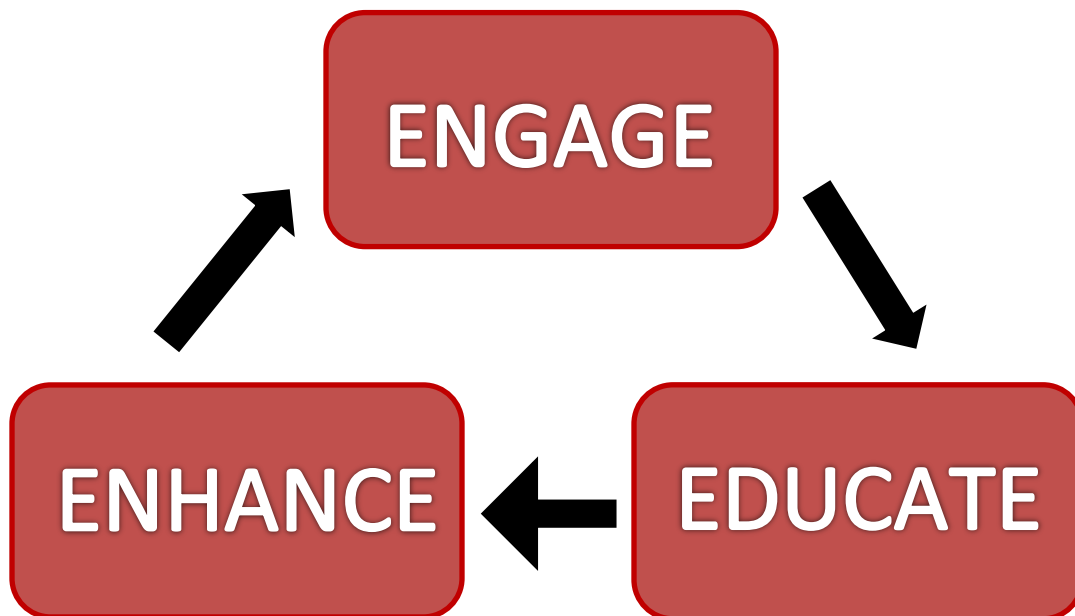




## THE CHAIRMANS PLAN

## ENGAGE

STUDENTS WHO RECEIVE A QUALITY INFUSION OF ARTS EDUCATION ARE:

- 4X MORE LIKELY TO BE RECOGNIZED FOR ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT
- HAVE LOWER RATES ON BEHAVIORAL PROBLEMS
- HAVE HIGHER ATTENDANCE RATES
- HAVE HIGHER GRADUATION RATES

CHILDREN WHO ARE RAISED IN POVERTY STRICKEN COMMUNITIES ARE MORE PRONE TO BECOME AT – RISK STUDENTS, EVENTUALLY SUCCUMBING SOCIALLY AND SOMETIMES PHYSICALLY DUE TO A LACK OF MOTIVATION AND SOCIOECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY. AT – RISK STUDENTS WHO HAVE ACCESS TO THE ARTS ALSO TEND TO HAVE BETTER ACADEMIC RESULTS, BETTER CAREER OPPORTUNITIES AND MORE CIVIC ENGAGEMENT.

REPUBLICAN IS NOT JUST A PARTY. ## EDUCATE

IN THE 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY, EDUCATION CONTINUES TO SERVE AS THE MOST PARAMOUNT CORNERSTONE OF COMMUNITY. THIS CATALYST REMAINS TO BE THE MOST IMPERATIVE RESOURCE PARTICULARLY IN MINORITY COMMUNITIES, OFFERING OPPORTUNITIES ONE NECESSARILY MAY NOT HAVE PROCURED WITHOUT THE FOUNDATION OF EDUCATION. ACCESS TO SOUND EDUCATION HAS BECOME A CHALLENGE IN BOTH SECONDARY AND HIGHER LEVEL INSTITUTIONS. AS PUBLIC SCHOOLS CONTINUE TO FAIL STUDENTS OF IMPOVERISHED COMMUNITIES, EMBRACING THE SUPPORT OF CHOICE SCHOOLS IS IMPORTANT TO THE BLACK REPUBLICAN CAUCUS OF FLORIDA.
